

STATEMENT REGARDING OVERHEAD FOR PROJECT FUNDING

The Jim H. McClung Lighting Research Foundation gives preference to projects where the preponderance of Foundation funds go directly to the research work.

The Foundation may consider research projects that include minimal overhead costs. However, any overhead costs must be specifically disclosed in the budget of any research proposal submitted and will be considered by the Foundation as part of the overall project evaluation. Projects with an overhead percentage of 15% or less are given preferential consideration. Projects with overhead that exceeds that amount will be considered but are not likely to receive favorable consideration in comparison to other research opportunities. Projects with overhead costs in excess of 50% will not be considered.

We strongly encourage universities and other institutions to identify funding methods where Foundation funds are allocated or earmarked directly to a specific project without going through a cost administrative or management accounting process.
